



New Program | Now Enrolling

Crisis Connections and ScalaNW are working together to link patients with opioid use disorder who have had an encounter with emergency services or been hospitalized to follow-up care. We are enrolling MOUD prescribers and peer support agencies from any practice setting to participate in the program.

What is it?

Designed with patient care at its heart, this program removes barriers patients face in the transition from emergency departments and acute care settings to ongoing support and treatment. Together, we can ensure individuals beginning their journey with Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) receive the timely and compassionate care they need for their recovery.

Why?

High risk encounters involving opioid use happen around the clock, outside typical operating hours. This makes scheduling follow-up care and connections to peer support challenging. This initiative of ScalaNW and the Recovery Help Line support 24/7 initiation of MOUD by ensuring that patients have a bridge to long-term support in an outpatient setting.
